SECTION SIX *HEALTH*

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE

EYES Corrosive, is destructive to the eye tissue on contact.

SKIN Corrosive, is destructive to skin tissue.

INHALATION Airborne concentration of dust may cause damage to upper respiratory contact.

INGESTION Will cause severe burns to the mouth, throat, and esophagus.

SECTION SEVEN *EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID*

EYES Immediately flush with large quantities of water for 15 minutes. Seek immediate medical attention.

SKIN Wash affected area with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

INHALATION Remove to a fresh air source. Seek medical attention.

INGESTION If swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water, milk, chalk, or magnesia.
