Exposure to loud noises can cause permanent hearing loss and continual exposure on the job increases this risk. OSHA mandates that workers exposed to more than an average 85 dB must be provided with hearing protection. The general rule of thumb is: *If you must raise your voice to be heard by someone standing three feet away you need hearing protection.*

### What is too loud?

Activity	Decibels
Normal conversation	50-70
Lawn mover /Leaf blower	85-90
250 hp hydroblast pump	96-100
Chainsaw/Small equipment	100-110
Siren/Jet Engine/Pneumatic Drill	110-120
Industrial machinery	120+
